Actions you hope/plan to take (next steps)	 ACTIONS are listed above, but in addition we will: Make sure to actively measure survival rates at the tree nursery stage and once planted in the forest. Investors need this information when considering whether to invest. Need to be able to demonstrate our metrics and track-record if we are to scale. Need to have accountability and transparent tracking systems if we are to attract investors.
